### Andy Dixon (Joshua Liner Gallery booth at Pulse Contemporary Art Fair)

Andy Dixon’s beautifully rendered and self-referential paintings pack a Duchampian punch. As an examination of the subjective aesthetic value of wealth, Dixon’s resplendent paintings depict symbols of the bourgeoisie in a flamboyant color palette that are a sight for sore eyes.
