



## Parra's "No Work Today" Exhibition Takes Over Joshua Liner Gallery



Beginning Thursday, November 17, Dutch artist and designer Parra will be taking over New York's Joshua Liner Gallery. "No Work Today" in turn accounts for the gallery's first-ever solo exhibition in partnership with Parra.

Parra's installation consists of 21 new works in total, featuring paintings on canvas, work on paper and a life-size sculpture.

In contrast to Parra's earlier work, prominently noting hybridized characters with bird-like features, the new exhibit eliminates faces and rather focuses further on the curvaceous forms of the female. Various pieces from the series then verge on abstraction, detailing the essence of painting and exploring the possibilities of line and form.

Parra's "No Work Today" will be showcased at Joshua Liner Gallery from November 17 through December 17.
