

## Hilary Pecis at Joshua Liner Gallery, New York

Joshua Liner Gallery, New York, is hosting an exhibition, titled 'New Paintings,' by artist Hilary Pecis, on view through May 20, 2017.

The exhibition presents new acrylic on canvas paintings by the Los Angeles-based artist, marking her first solo with the gallery, as well in New York. Moving away from her previous practice of creating new worlds through her paintings, these works are inspired by the artist's surroundings in Los Angeles. The exhibition consists still life, landscapes, and interior scenes, capturing Pecis' personal memories while honoring and referencing the larger tradition of the form of painting. The title of the show itself is both broad and descriptive for Pecis, as the medium of painting is a real inspiration for the show, as all of her works in this body, the medium plays the role of central motivation. The artist explores and combines the formal aspects of painting with her own techniques and subjects, which are all coming out of her own experiences, chosen for their formal attributes.
